1. Food businesses or premises (including mobile vans) registered to sell food must display a current copy of their registration certificate (food businesses only).
2. All food at the Hunting & Wild Food Festival Event 2018 is prepared for sale at the food stall holder's risk.
3. Health and Safety procedures at each stall is the stall holder's responsibility. Paraweka Marae Trustees & the Hunting & Wild Food Festival Event 2018 organisers are not liable for any incident that occurs by the operation of individual stall holders.
4. Food stall operators must have the right equipment to be able to sell food safely. Please ensure that you have food packaging (ie. Serviettes, paper bags, tin foil etc.) so the public is able to safely consume food.
5. Maintain hygiene standards with the preparation and sale of food at all times during the event in accordance with the Food Safety Act 2014 (see section at bottom of page).
6. All stalls to be operated in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.
7. Food businesses must supply their own fire extinguisher.

Note: No more than two types of food per stall. Stall size is 3m by 3m. Stall allocation will be at the discretion of the **Stalls Organiser & Event Organiser**

There will be power & water available for stalls & mobile food vans. No other equipment provided. Please bring own tables, gazebo, extension cords (if applicable) and **ensure you have sufficient change/float for your sales.**

PERSONAL HYGIENE

- People who have cold or flu symptoms or have had sickness or diarrhoea within 48 hours of the event, or anyone with sores/ lesions on their hands, neck or head should not help with food for the event.
- Disposable gloves - if you are using them change them between activities, e.g. after handling raw food and before handling cooked food.

PREPARING FOOD

- Wash hands thoroughly after touching raw foods and before touching other food.
- Thoroughly clean equipment and surfaces.
- Use separate utensils (e.g. knives), when preparing raw and cooked foods.

COOKING FOOD

- Processed meat such as mince patties and sausages should not be pink in the middle and any juices should run clear.

FOOD ALLERGIES

Customers who have a food allergy need to know whether a particular ingredient is in your food. Know what is in your food:

- The most common allergens – nuts, gluten, shellfish, fish, eggs, dairy, sesame seeds, added sulphites, and bee products.
- There will be a designated medical area at the event if needed.
